The PTFA would like you to help us celebrate, and we invite all children to take part in our **Challenge 300**.

Set over 300 days (Monday 1st February to Saturday 27th November), we challenge the children to do 300 of something...run or walk 300 laps of the garden, bake 300 cupcakes, build something with 300 pieces of Lego, cycle 300km, skip 300 times with a rope, write a 300 word story, collect 300 things, stay silent for 300 minutes...or anything of their own choice (it doesn't have to be 300 in one go - remember there are 300 days!). There will be certificates for all who take part, and some prizes, and there is no limit to the number of challenges someone can do. If your child is in Year 6, they can still take part and share their results whenever they have them.
